The Head of Barge leads the international barge team supporting educational facilitators and office staff in the day to day running, training, delivery and long-term planning of the Program. The Head of Barge is based in Bangkok.

The Head of Barge reports to the Traidhos Head of Community and works closely with the Head of Community to manage and develop the mission and vision of the Program.

The day to day workload is split between teaching and leading in the field on trips and office management of staff and program. The initial contract will be for three years subject to a satisfactory 3 month probationary period.
