Traidhos Camp Seasonal Camp Facilitator Key Roles

As a seasonal Camp Facilitator you will work closely with other staff in the camp team. You must become familiar and confident to lead a wide range of activities and to have a working knowledge of operating procedures and safety/risk for each area used by camp.

During camps you will support all activities taking an equal part in teaching students with others in the camp team. You will interact with students, chaperones and trip team members. You will share in night supervision of students in open camps providing the pastoral care young people need when they are away from home. You will share meal times, activity times and free time periods with students.

During non-contact time you will support with prepare camp teaching materials, create work books and support with on going jobs which may include social media posts, sending photos to parents through the camp group, cleaning equipment and similar.

In consultation with the Head of Camp and Camp Leader:

Pre and Post camp

- Participate in staff camp meeting with Teaching Team
- Be aware of child protection, risk assessment and operating policies, risk assessments for the areas you will be working in and camp operating procedures
- Bring a positive work ethic and maintain good team working and communication with camp co-workers
- Complete camp evaluation for each camp with camp team
- Prepare equipment and camp materials
- Clean, repair and return all equipment
- Create a camp website report

During Camp

- Participate in staff camp meeting with Teaching Team
- Help to supervise safety of participants during camp and free time activities
- Take part in all routine activities as part of the staff team
- Communicate with all participants and staff
- Help campers to feel comfortable in the camp setting by talking to them and sharing in games
- Lead games, activities and reflections
- Promote living as a Global Citizen
