Summer 2023 is our first busy camp season since COVID! Seasonal staff will join a small existing team of environmental educators and past camp staff to lead the summer activity.

In June we will welcome seasonal camp staff, complete orientation, safeguarding reviews and form the teams that will work on each camp program. From mid June until late August, the campus will be busy with visiting campers.

Most 9 – 14 year old camps are residential lasting 7 or 14 days. Each 7 day period you should expect to work 5 days and get 2 days to rest and manage yourself. The days may not be consecutive. You will mostly work either the day program (breakfast until 5pm with handover at dinner time, or the evening shift 5pm until 9am with a handover at breakfast). However, when the campers go off campus for an overnight visit, one camp team will be with the campers for the entire off-campus period.

Most 4 – 8 programs are day camps. These run Monday to Friday. You may have some preparation to do outside of the camp day.

Some campers come for day camps, arriving after breakfast and leaving after dinner.

During Summer 2023 many of the campers will travel from China to join the camps. While some may be fluent English speakers campers joining English camp are likely to be beginner users of English, so staff with experience of working in a teaching English situation, or who speak Chinese are at an advantage.

Most camp programs have a strong connection to the outdoors including time on our farm, cooking on fires and doing environmental activities. The English component of English Camp is taught by a local language school. Camp staff are responsible for all other activities.

All programs are written and games and activities have activity write ups to support your facilitation. However, there is room for you to share your favourite games, energisers and campfire activities!

You should expect to work hard, have fun working with like-minded people passionate about leading young people in a camp situation and spend a summer in an amazing part of northern Thailand.
